PNG Development Cooperation Environment

- Bougainville Peace Agreement clearly mandates that the National Government leads on development cooperation
- Kavieng Declaration on Aid Effectiveness
- 2014 ABG / PNG / DPs Resolution (refer next slide)
- 2015 PNG Development Cooperation Policy
 - DNPM Coordination mechanisms include: High-Level Forum, Policy Level Dialogue, Sector Consultations, technical level consultations and Development Partner Strategies.

ABG - DP Resolution - 2014

Resolution Agreed:

- ABG Priorities to drive DP Cooperation
- ABG and DPs to identify funding Gaps
- A minimum of 2 ABG DP meetings every year
- DP Coordination meetings to be themed
- Regular meetings between ABG Chief Sec and DPs
- DP committed to providing information and data on activities following ABG systems
- DP support will be reflected in the national and ABG budget

Toward Effective Development Cooperation

- Aid Effectiveness Principles draw from 50 years of development cooperation experience
- Busan Declaration (2011) and Global Partnership for Effective Development Co-operation

ABG Development Financing and Coordination

Mission: Ensuring the effective use of the external assistance provided by Development Partners, so as to guarantee coordination and harmonization in accordance with the development priorities set by the ABG

- DP Coordination sits within the office of the Chief Secretary
- Specialized unit and staff established within Office of Chief Secretary
- Current focus of work:
 - Ensuring synergy with the National Development Cooperation Policy and coordination Mechanisms
 - Restoration and implementation of the 2014 Resolution Agreement
 - Training of ABG staff on aid effectiveness
 - Collection of ODA data
 - Establishment of Aid Database and associated processes

Next Steps – Moving Forward

- Alignment and compliance with the Peace Agreement and National Policy of Development Cooperation
- Transparency and Alignment of DP assistance with ABG Strategic Development Plan
- Collection, validation and analysis of data from DPs
- Establishment of coordination mechanisms within ABG
- Implementation of the 2014 resolution
- Structured dialogue and mechanisms with DPs.
- Development of Longer term project to Support Aid Coordination





Development Finance PNG 2000 -2011




PNG Capital Investment Budget Trend – 2003 - 2017





Current PNG National Trend in ODA Assistance





PNG Development Financing 2013 (PNG)













ODA disbursement by DPs (2015 – 2017)




DP 2016 Support by OECD DAC Sector
