Get your guide to investing in Bougainville

Investor engages with government, landowners or local businesses and lodges initial interest with Form A (non-mandatory)



Investor receives application pack (Form B), submits application and pays fees to the Department of Commerce, Trade and Investment



The Department lodges and then assess application



Inward Investment Board either makes a decision on license, or makes a recommendation to the Bougainville Executive Council (BEC) for a decision



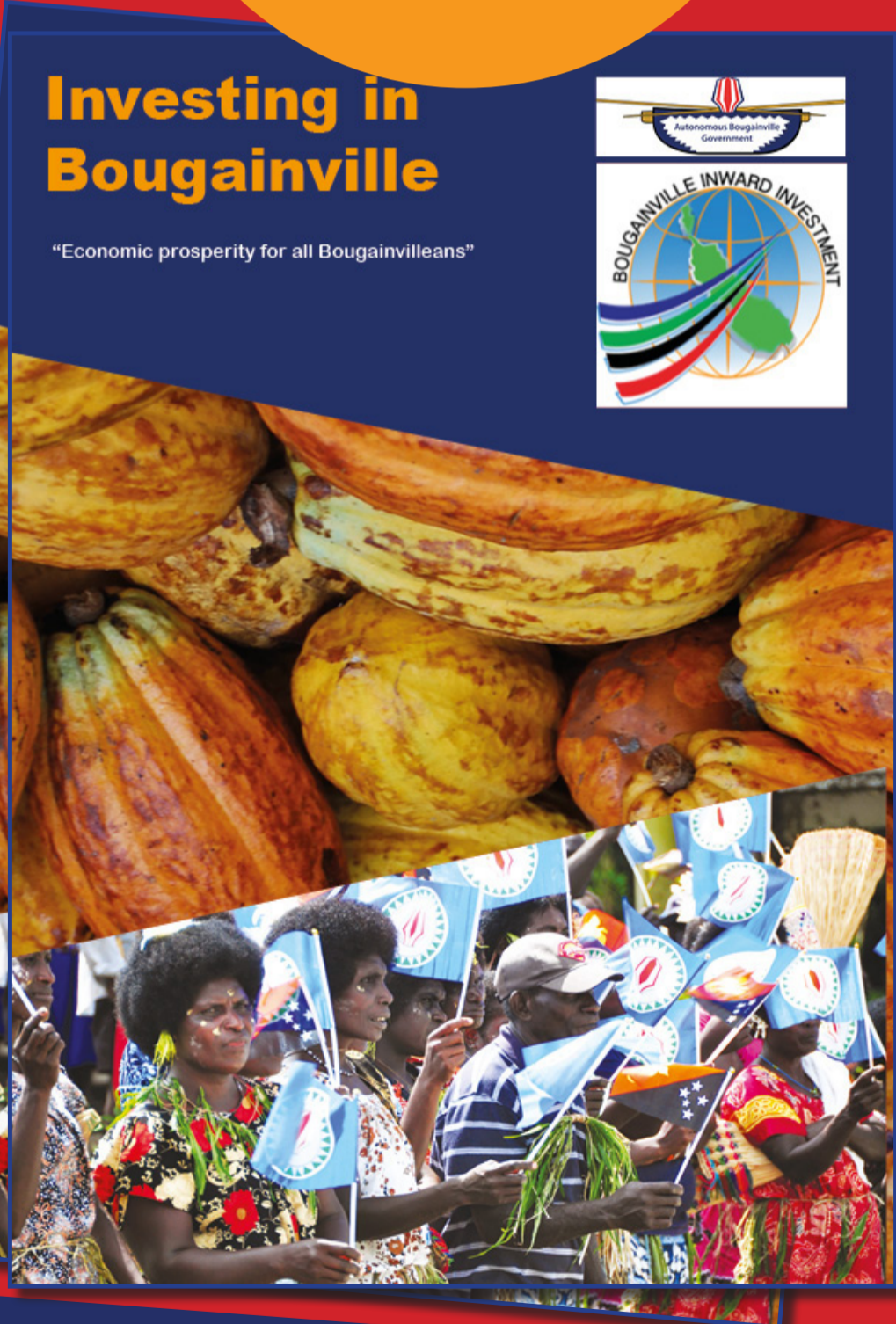
If a license is issued, the investor then proceeds to meet other regulatory requirements



When all relevant approvals are received, the investment is made



Investor submits annual returns to the Department, which monitors compliance within the conditions of the license
