SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION (2018) ACT 2018

Being an Act to appropriate additional sums from the Bougainville Consolidated Revenue Fund for expenditure in the 2018 fiscal year in respect of the general public services

MADE by the House of Representatives, to come into operation as set out in Section 2(1)

1 Short title

This is the *Supplementary Appropriation (2018) Act 2018*.

2 Commencement and expiry

- (1) This Act comes into operation on its certification under Section 66 of the *Bougainville Constitution*.
- (2) This Act ceases to have effect on 31 December 2018.

3 Definitions

In this Act—

Minister means the Minister responsible for treasury and finance;

Public Finance Act means the *Bougainville Public Finance (Management and Administration) Act 2014*.

4 Appropriation and application of K14,288,000

- (1) In addition to the sum appropriated under the *Appropriation (2018) Act 2017*, the sum of K14,288,000 is appropriated from the Bougainville Consolidated Revenue Fund for expenditure in respect of general public services for the fiscal year ending on 31 December 2018.
- (2) The sum may be applied for the additional activities of each service specified in Column 1 of the table in Schedule 1 in the amount specified in Column 3 of the table.
- (3) The additional activities of a service are as set out in the supplementary estimates of expenditure for the fiscal year ending on 31 December 2018 tabled in the House of Representatives by the Minister under Section 22(4) of the Public Finance Act.
